Dear friends!

The year 2020 has been a year of tests of strength for us. The coronavirus pandemic has changed the lives of Kyiv residents, Ukrainians, nations and people all over the world.

It has been a year of tough decisions for the capital's authorities and of superhuman effort for our doctors in the fight for the lives and health of Kyiv residents.

In 2020, Kyiv learnt to live under severe quarantine for the first time in several decades. And I am sincerely grateful to the people of Kyiv for understanding the need for such measures and complying with anti-epidemic requirements.

Unfortunately, Kyiv confronted the pandemic virtually on its own. The capital's public health institutions were provided with everything necessary for both individual protection of medical personnel and treatment of patients at the municipal expense. We have also introduced a municipal allowance for medics and increased salaries for social workers whose workload increased during the quarantine. In total, 386 million UAH have been allocated from the city budget for the fight against coronavirus in 2020. And more than 1 billion UAH for additional payments to our healthcare staff.

Realizing that quarantine will hit the capital's entrepreneurs the hardest, the city authorities have consciously decided to cut Kyiv's budget revenues to support small and medium-sized businesses and have made several decisions regarding local benefits and preferences for businesses.

The pandemic has demonstrated the so-called 'growth areas' - areas of city life that need to be made more resilient and adapted to the current threats and challenges. We are talking about the development of the capital's health, social, educational and security infrastructure, strengthening the capacity of local government and a more dynamic transformation of public facilities and services. Therefore, my priorities as the mayor of the capital are in line with the demands of the times - restoring the city's economy, implementing large-scale infrastructure projects and ensuring that the rights of Kyiv residents to quality health care, education, inclusivity and other social services are respected.

The COVID-19 pandemic has certainly made adjustments to the pace of projects in the capital. However, despite the economic crisis caused by the pandemic, in 2020, 27 wards in hospitals in Kyiv were renovated, cutting-edge medical equipment was purchased, and five child care centers were opened. Also, 80 parks and public gardens were renovated, 131 road infrastructure facilities were reconstructed, and over 100 kilometers of faulty heating networks were replaced. The construction of the underground line to Vynohradar continues: tunnels from the future «Mostytska» station to «Prospect Pravdy» station are being actively built there, and over 700 meters of the line have been installed. Despite the difficult epidemiological situation, work also continues on the Podolsko-Voskresenska bridge crossing.

Kyiv, as a city of social innovation, continues to develop its infrastructure and technology. In 2020, the capital increased the number of Kyiv Smart City services.



To ensure the safety of Kyiv residents and visitors, almost 6,000 cameras of the citywide video surveillance system and 35 emergency call buttons, which can be used to immediately contact an operator and get help, operate in parks and public places in the capital. In addition, we opened three situation centers and established cooperation with operational units of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and the Security Service of Ukraine. We were the first Ukrainian city to implement and scale the Kyiv Smart City School communication and educational platform to other cities of the country. We have improved the electronic registration service for children care centers in the capital.

We still have a lot to do. We are continuing the transformation of Kyiv, changing our city, making it a beautiful and comfortable European capital.

I am convinced that together with the public, we will overcome all challenges with dignity. After all, we love Kyiv and together we are making it a city where one wants to live and work, study and have an interesting holiday, where one can be proud to invite guests.

THE HISTORY OF THE COUNTRY IN THE ARCHITECTURE OF THE CAPITAL

Pedagogical Museum of Ukraine of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences
Kyiv City Teacher's House. Museum of the Ukrainian People's Republic (UNR)



The history of Kyiv is reflected not only in the stories but also in the buildings that have witnessed these events and have undergone changes in appearance and functionality according to the trends of the times.

One such building is the Pedagogical Museum, whose construction began 120 years ago, in 1910, and was officially opened in October 1912. The museum itself was founded as early as 1901. During the first decade of its existence, it was located on the premises of various educational institutions and in private houses, such as the Troitskyi People's House and Higher Women's Courses.

Besides exhibition halls, the Museum had a library, a reading room, special rooms for displaying school books and equipment, a reference desk, a large auditorium for public events. The first director of the museum was the Ukrainian educationalist Oleksandr Muzychenko.

The history of the house

Ukrainian Central Rada and the UPR Directorate 1917–1919

After the February Revolution, the museum was closed down and its building housed the first Ukrainian parliament, the Ukrainian Central Rada (1917-1918) and the UPR Directorate (1918-1919).

It was in this building that the Central Rada (the revolutionary parliament of Ukraine) adopted the Universals, proclaiming the sovereignty of the state. The first Universal, on June 10 (23), 1917 proclaimed Ukraine's autonomy within Russia; it stated that the main source of power in the country was the Ukrainian people. The second one, on July 3 (16), 1917 proclaimed that the final form of Ukrainian autonomy would be decided by the Constituent Assembly of Russia. The third - on November 7 (20), 1917 - proclaimed the Ukrainian People's Republic: Ukraine was not completely separated from Russia, but all the power belonged only to the Central Rada and the General Secretariat. The Fourth Universal issued on January 9 (22), 1918 proclaimed the independence of Ukraine. The UPR was proclaimed "an autonomous, independent, free sovereign state of the Ukrainian people". The Central Rada passed a law declaring Ukrainian as the state language and raising the issue of training teachers to teach in the Ukrainian language.

The building also played host to celebrations of the opening of various educational institutions and the founding of the Pedagogical Academy, the forerunner of the Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine. The premises hosted the first two congresses of Ukrainian teachers (spring and autumn 1917). The main issues at the congresses were the Ukrainization of education, the creation of new textbooks on the history and geography of Ukraine and the Ukrainian language; and the development of new programmes.

The premises of the museum housed the Bureau of the All-Ukrainian Teachers' Union, which was headed by Mrs Sofia Rusova. The newly established Ukrainian State Academy of Arts also worked in the same building.

Soviet period 1917–1990

During the Soviet period, the building housed various institutions, including the Proletarian Museum (from 1921) and the Museum of Revolution and the History of the Communist Party (1925-1938). In 1922 the House of Education Employees was founded, which in 1934 was reorganized into the Kyiv Teacher's House as a state cultural and educational institution created to meet the cultural and professional needs of employees of educational institutions. In the 1930s, under the management of Pavlo Alioshyn, the building was completed and adapted for housing the Lenin Museum, opened in 1938 as the Kyiv branch of the Central Museum of Lenin, which existed in the building of the Pedagogical Museum from 1938 to 1982. (During the occupation of 1941-1943, the Museum of Ancient History was located there).


The Museum of Pedagogy was restored in 1977. In 1982, it was renamed into the Teacher's House. In 1983, by Decree No. 172 of the Council of Ministers of the Ukrainian SSR, the National Pedagogical Museum was established under the authority of the Pedagogical Society of the Ukrainian SSR; it was housed in a historical building - the Kyiv City Teacher's House.

Ukrainian independence 1991...

At the time of Ukraine's independence, the Ukrainian Cabinet of Ministers passed a resolution in 1992. The Teacher's House was transferred to the functional subordination of the Academy of Sciences. In 2002, the Kyiv City Council reorganized the Teacher's House into the Kyiv City Teacher's House.

Nowadays, the historical building of the Education Building, which is a monument of architecture, houses the Teacher's House, the Pedagogical Museum, a branch of the State Pedagogical Scientific Library of Ukraine named after V. A. Sukhomlynskyi, the City Council of the Education Employees Association, and a branch of the National Museum of the History of Ukraine "Museum of the Ukrainian Revolution 1917-1921", the exhibition of which was opened in 2008. The Kyiv City Teacher's House is a center of pedagogical, scientific, creative and artistic disciplines and researches, an exchange of quality experience and a venue for specialist forums, meetings and conferences. There are amateur art groups and various clubs for teachers and pupils.








Natural mobility of the population, persons



Population migration, persons




Distribution of the resident population by individual age groups and gender












Efficiency of treatment of tuberculosis patients at the outpatient level, %




Main epidemic indicators of tuberculosis, cases per 100 thousand persons







Number of treated nephrology patients 2018-2020, persons




Share of unemployed youth under the age of 35, %







Sales of industrial products, billion UAH




Average wage in industry (December), UAH





Expenditures on technological innovations, million UAH



Expenditures on research and development, million UAH






Structure of costs for innovation by the main activities of the processing manufacturing in 2019, %






Volume of construction work performed by type, million UAH






Capital investments in 2020, mill. UAH



Direct investments (equity instruments) in the economy of Kyiv, million USD




Volumes of direct investment per person, USD












The share of Kyiv in the volume of goods exported from Ukraine, %










