Dear friends!

The year 2023 marked another year of full-scale war and our unity. The capital, like the entire country, lived under the difficult conditions of martial law. Kyiv was a target of the aggressor and bravely defended itself against deadly missile and drone attacks, strengthening defensive positions, restoring war-damaged housing and infrastructure, and implementing the most important projects planned before the large-scale war.

Despite all the difficulties, this year even more businesses gradually resumed their operations, and small and medium-sized businesses began to grow in the capital, which is important for Kyiv's economy.

In 2023, the priorities for the city authorities were ensuring the stable functioning of the capital metropolis in case of emergencies during

the heating season, developing the fund of civil protection structures – shelters and simple shelters, developing systemic services to enhance the resilience of residents of different social and age groups, increasing and initiating new mental health services, providing rehabilitative support for military personnel and their families, and finding opportunities to increase budget funding for the needs of the military and veterans.

New support locations for citizens during wartime were also created - the Center for Resilience and the 'Comprehensive Support Center for Combatants "KYIV MILITARY HUB."' Effective solutions were implemented on the initiative of the Kyiv City Coordination Council on Reintegration and Support of Kyiv's Defenders and Defendresses of Ukraine and their families.

The city also addressed the issue of internally displaced persons. In 2023, Kyiv became a second home for nearly half a million displaced persons from active combat zones, implementing mechanisms for the permanent integration of new residents of the capital - providing temporary housing, employment, and access to medical, social, and educational services.

After the war, it will be time for the reconstruction of Kyiv and Ukraine. Since the beginning of the large-scale invasion, we have seen the results of effective cooperation between local government bodies, state authorities, international and non-governmental organizations, volunteers, and the residents of the capital. We will continue to build on this experience.

I sincerely thank all international partners and friends for their much-needed help and support for the capital and Ukraine during this dramatic time for us!

No matter how difficult it is – we will endure and achieve victory!

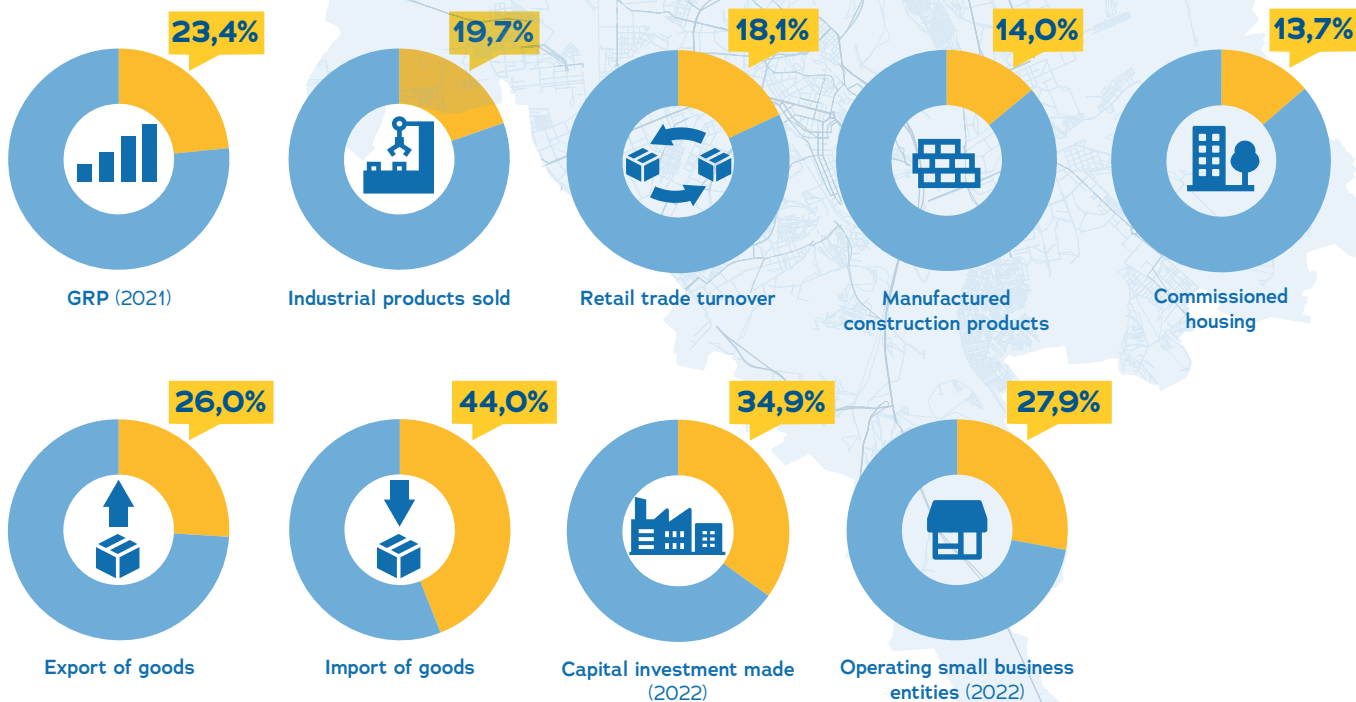

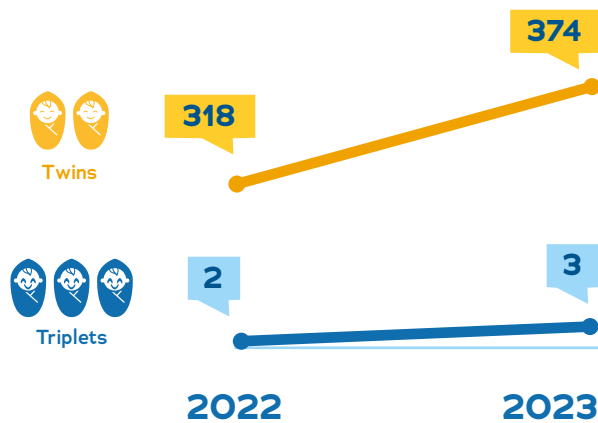
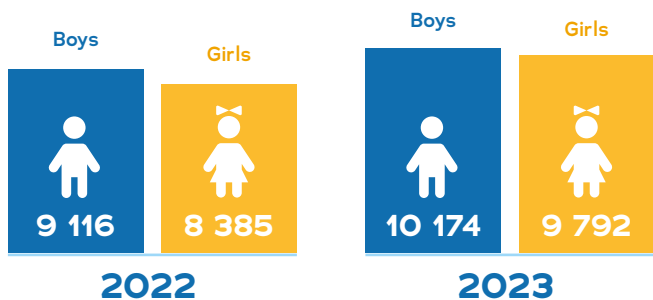
Kyiv's share in the economy of Ukraine

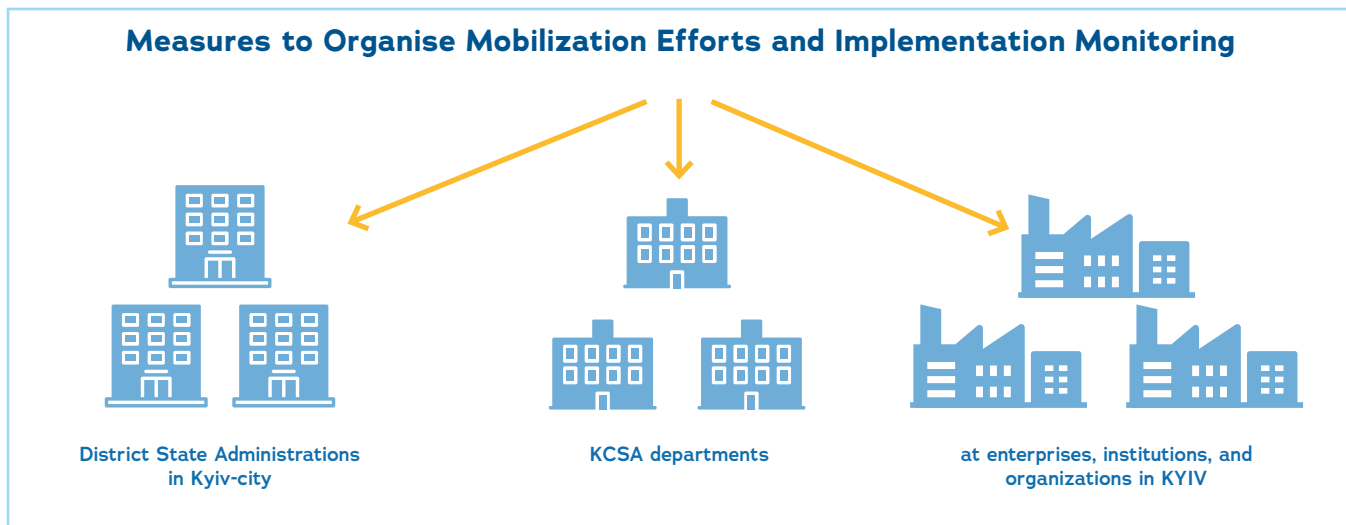

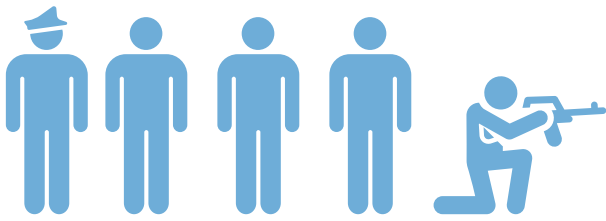

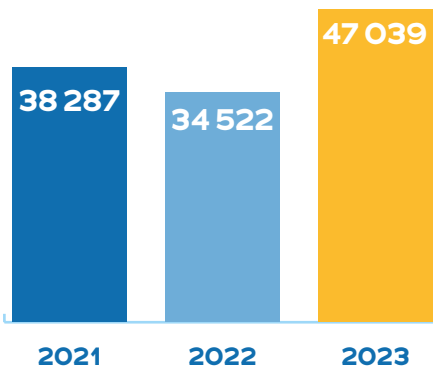

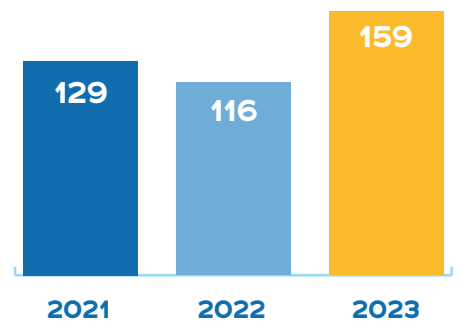
Total criminal offences dynamics, units



Indicator of public confidence in the police*,%

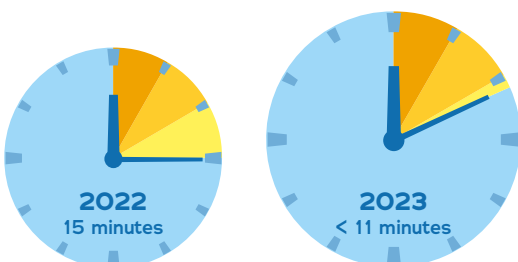


Crime rate per 10 thousand people

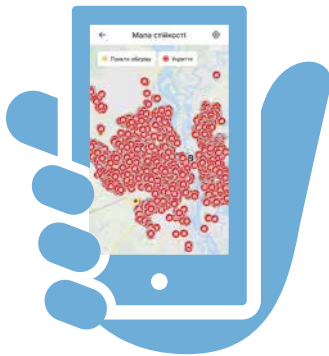


Map of shelters



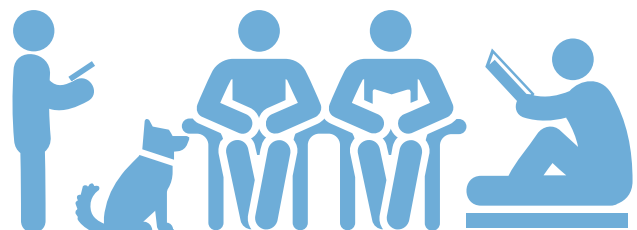

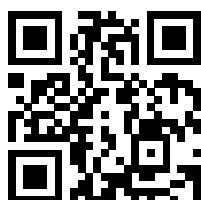

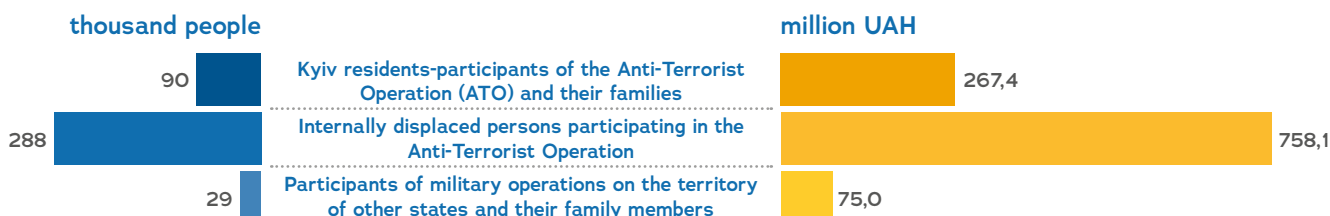

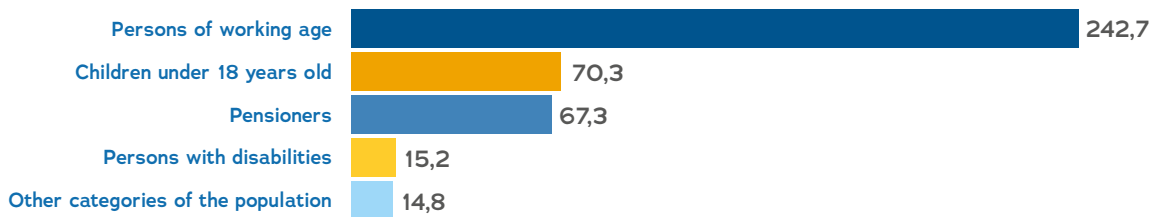

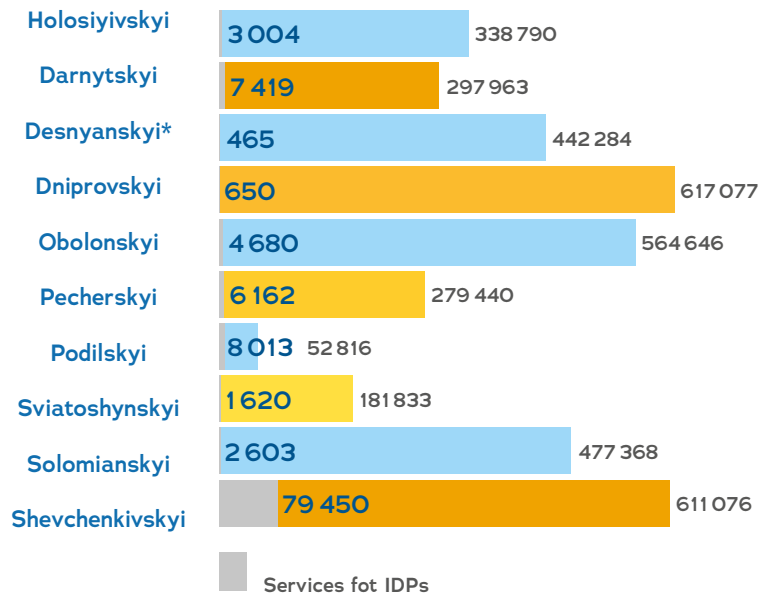

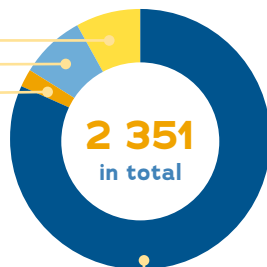

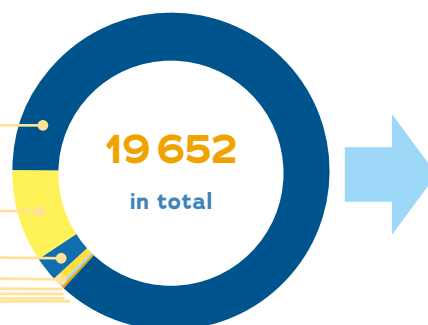

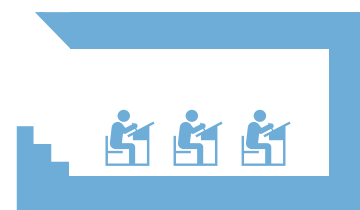

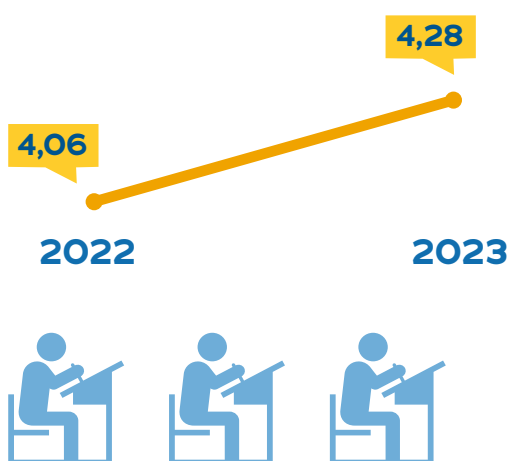

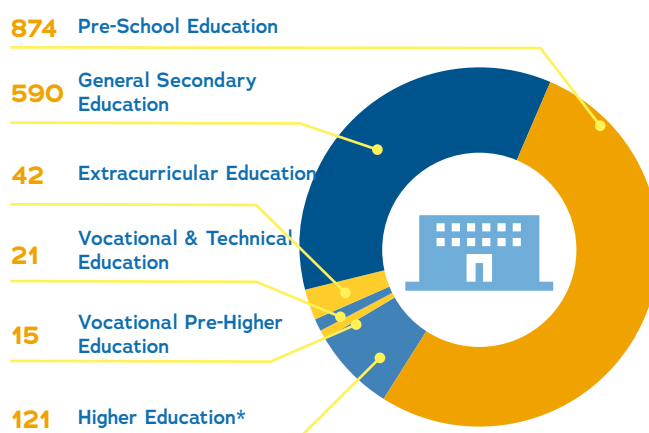

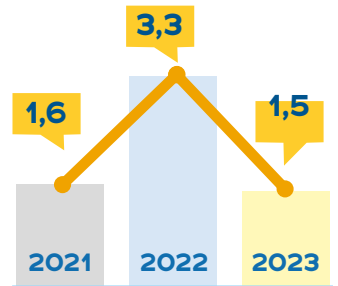

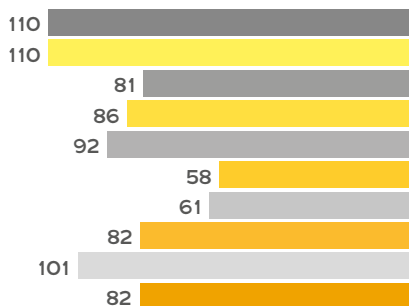

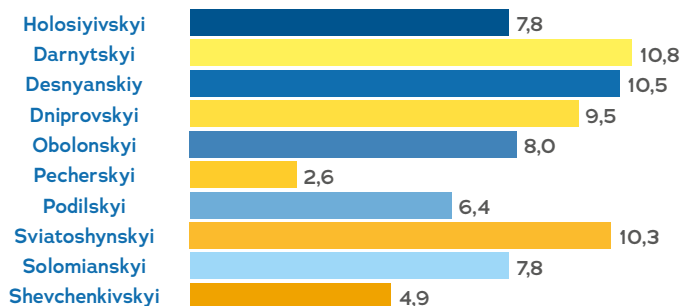

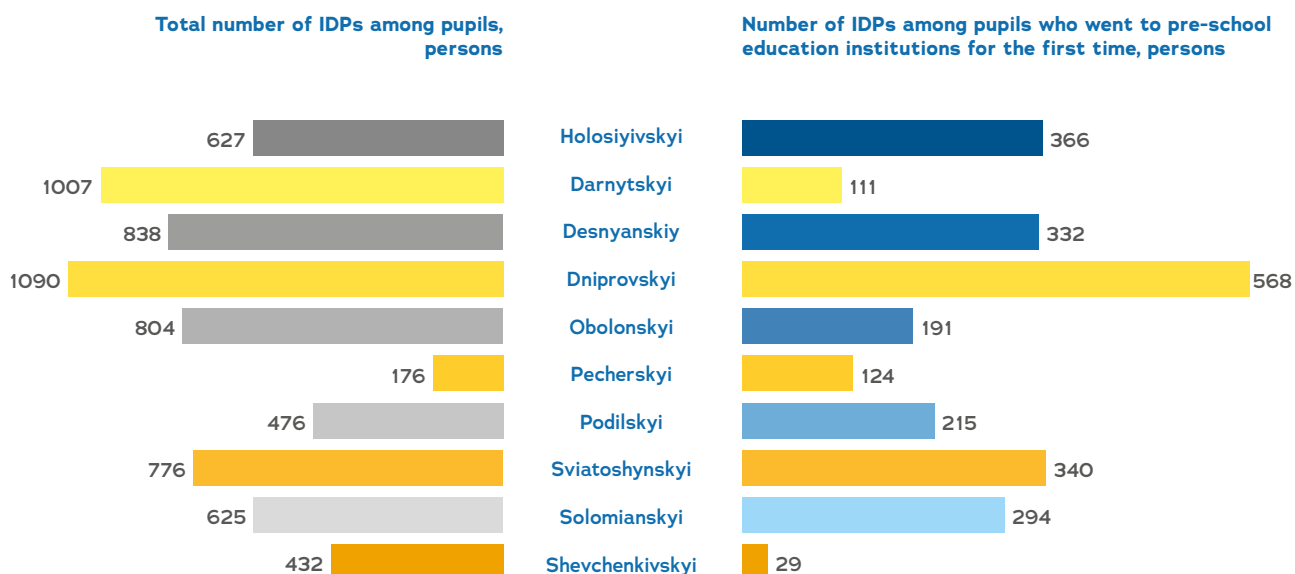

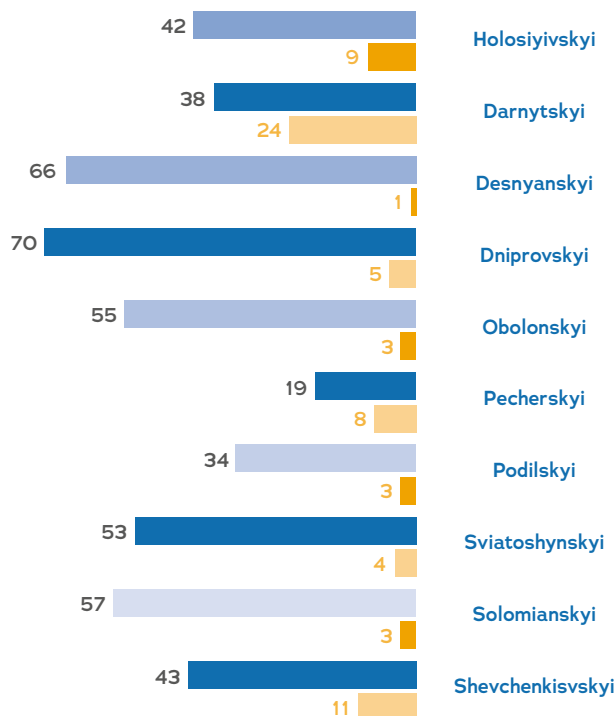

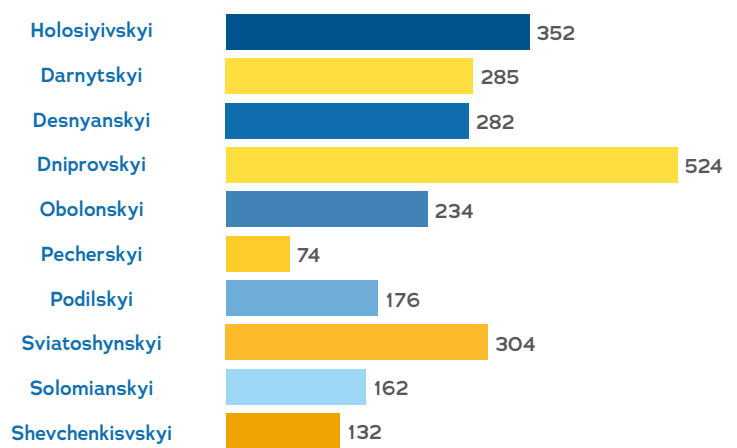

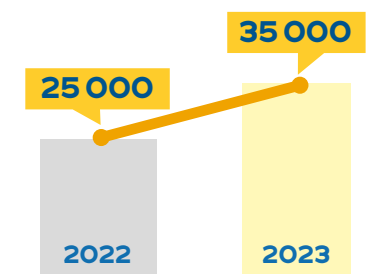

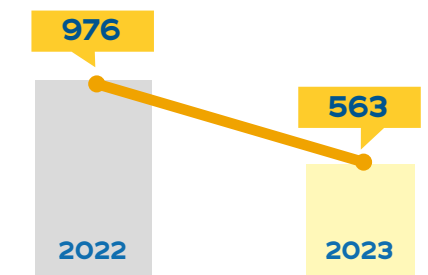

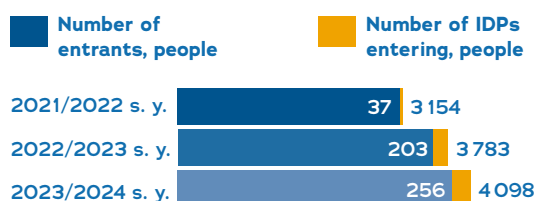

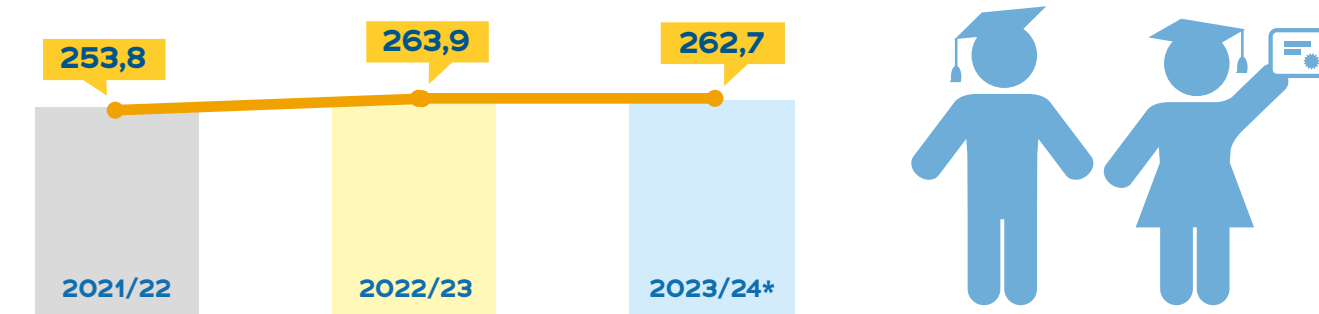

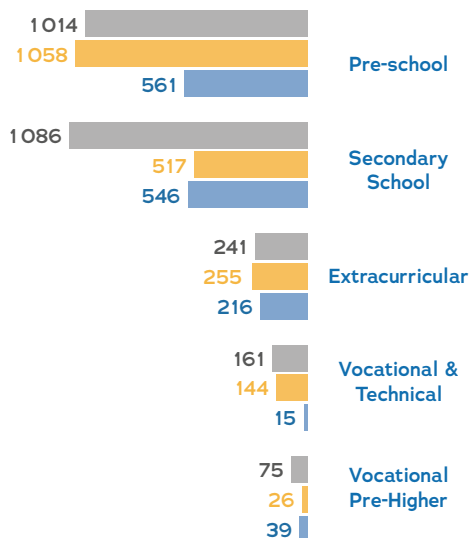

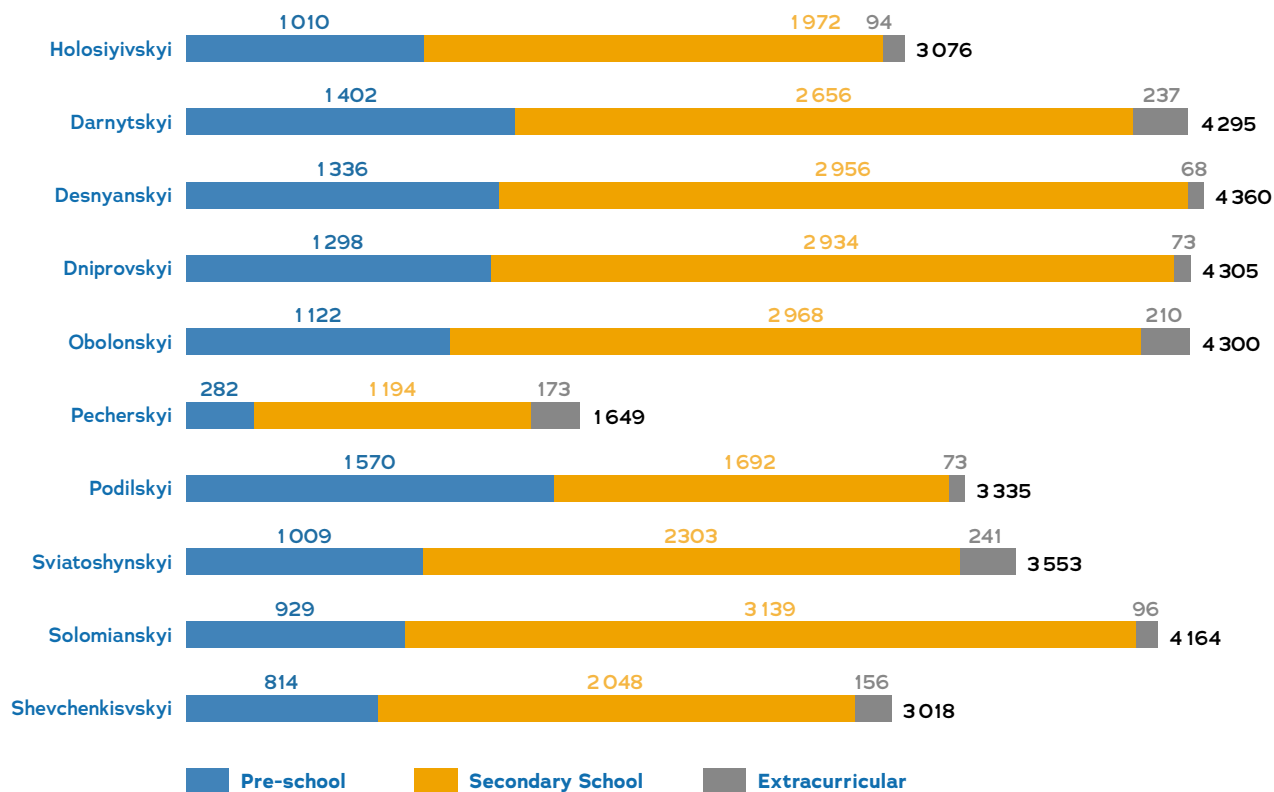

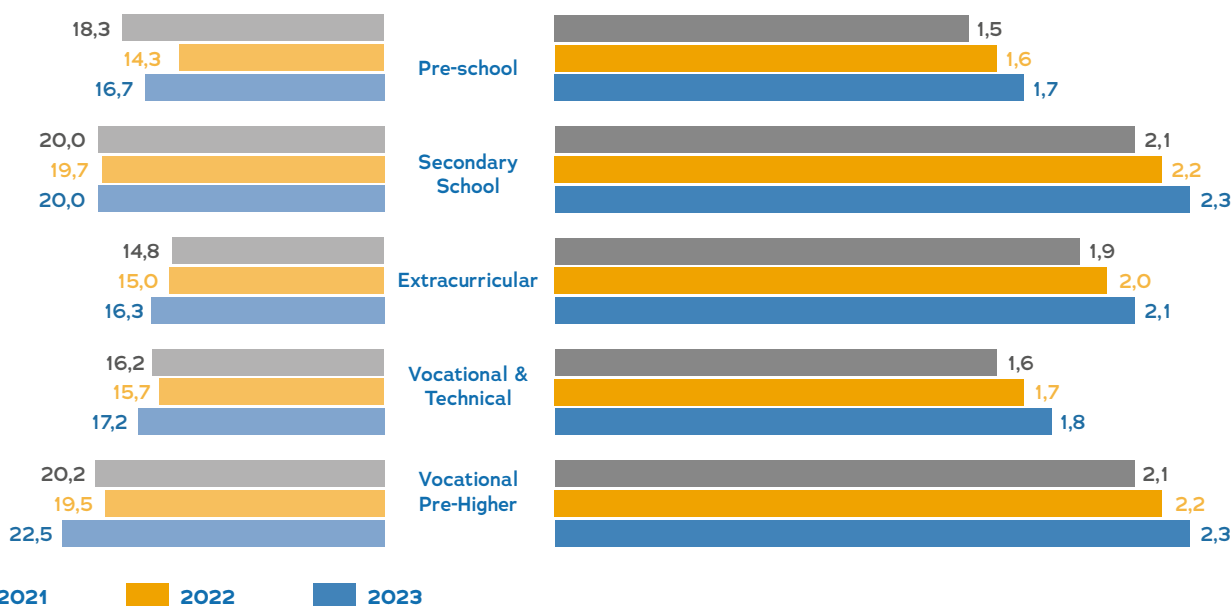

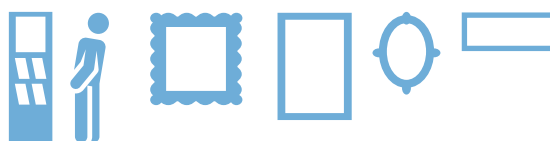

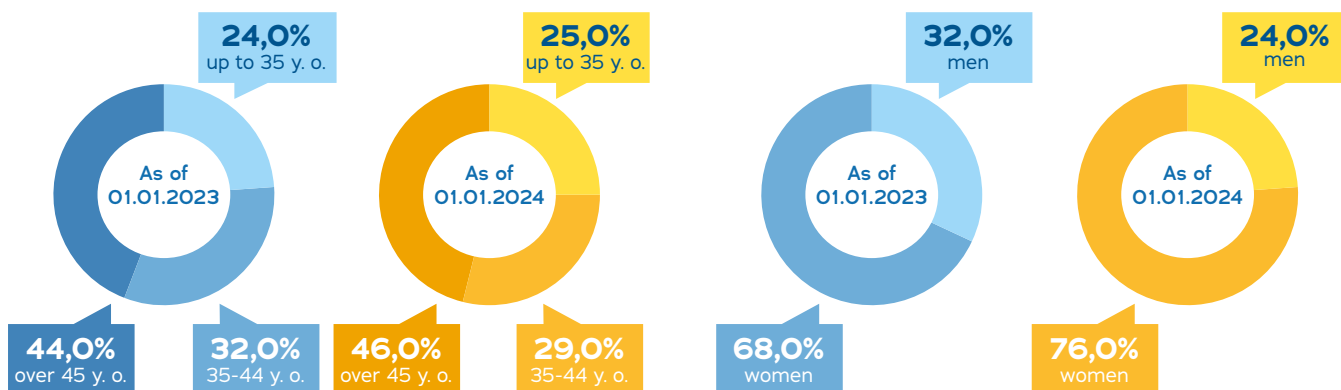

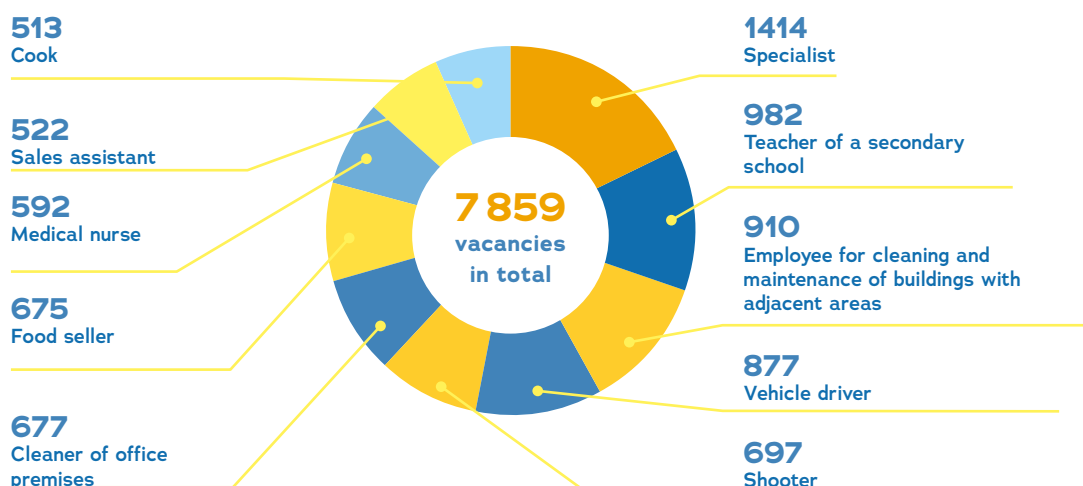


By age group

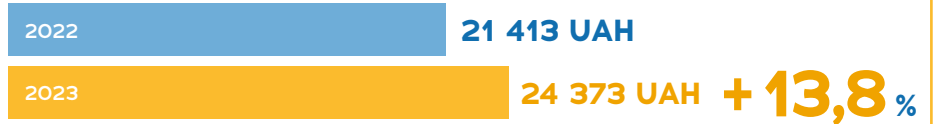
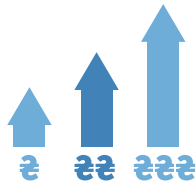
Ratio of the unemployment rate women to men

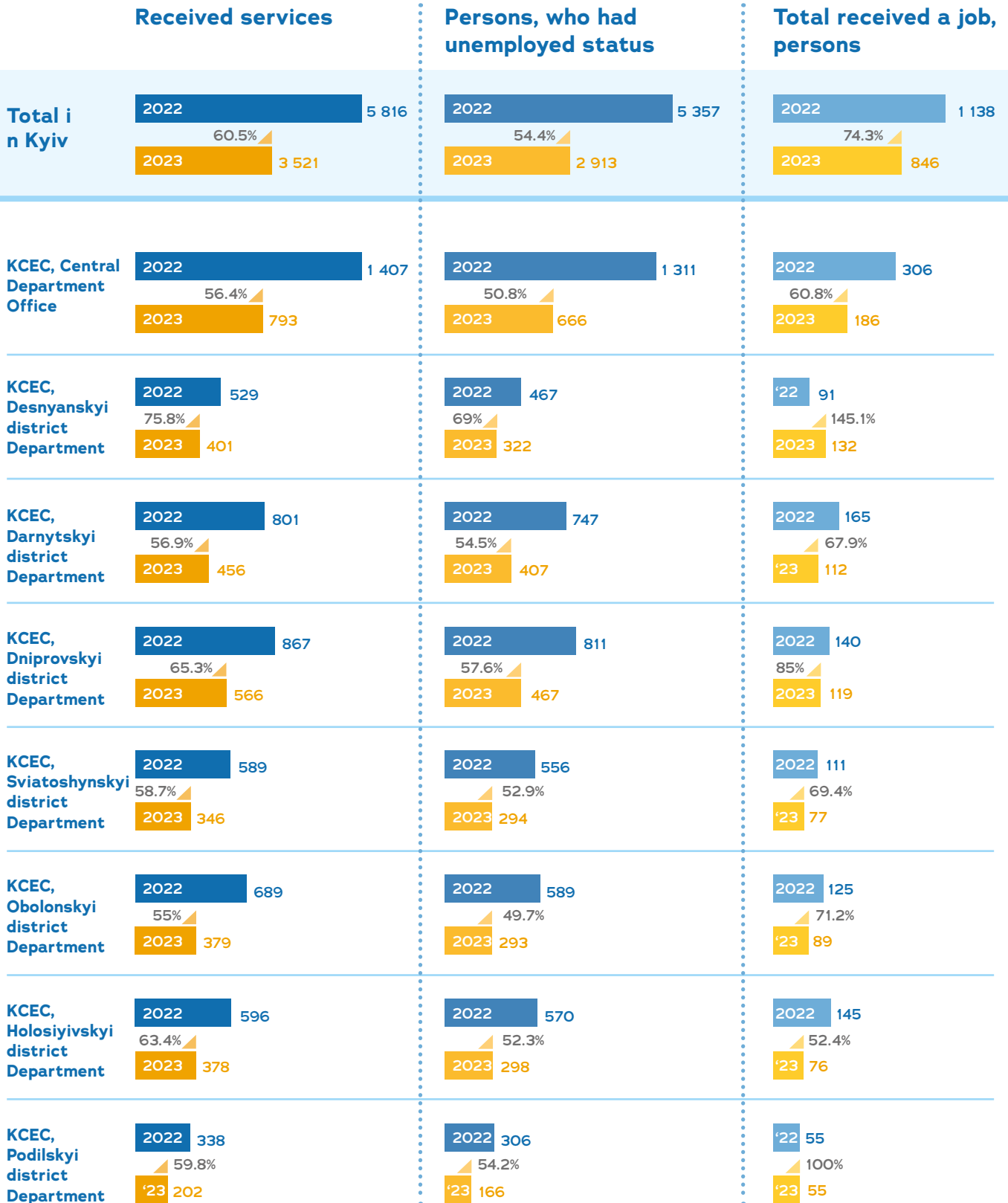

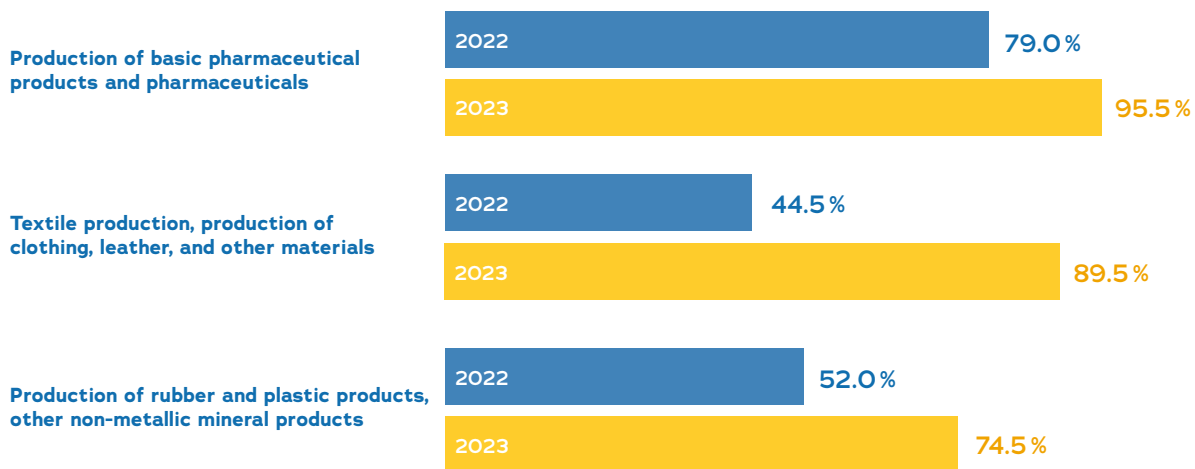
Industrial output indices

Reduction of production by main types of industrial activity



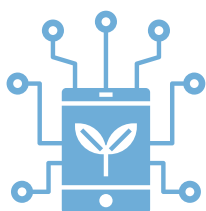
Volume of industrial products sold, UAH billion

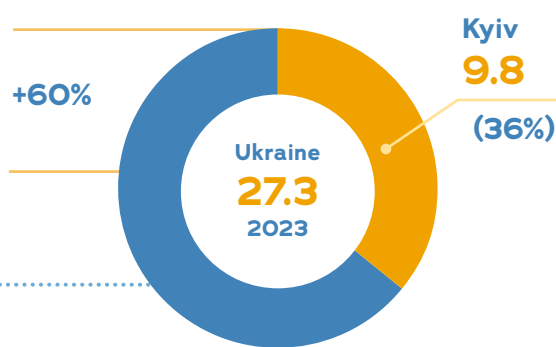

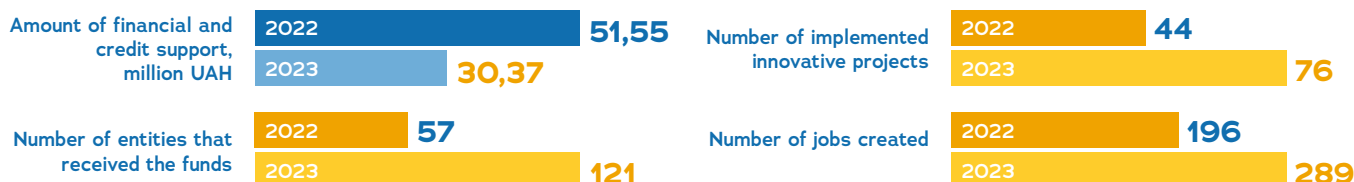

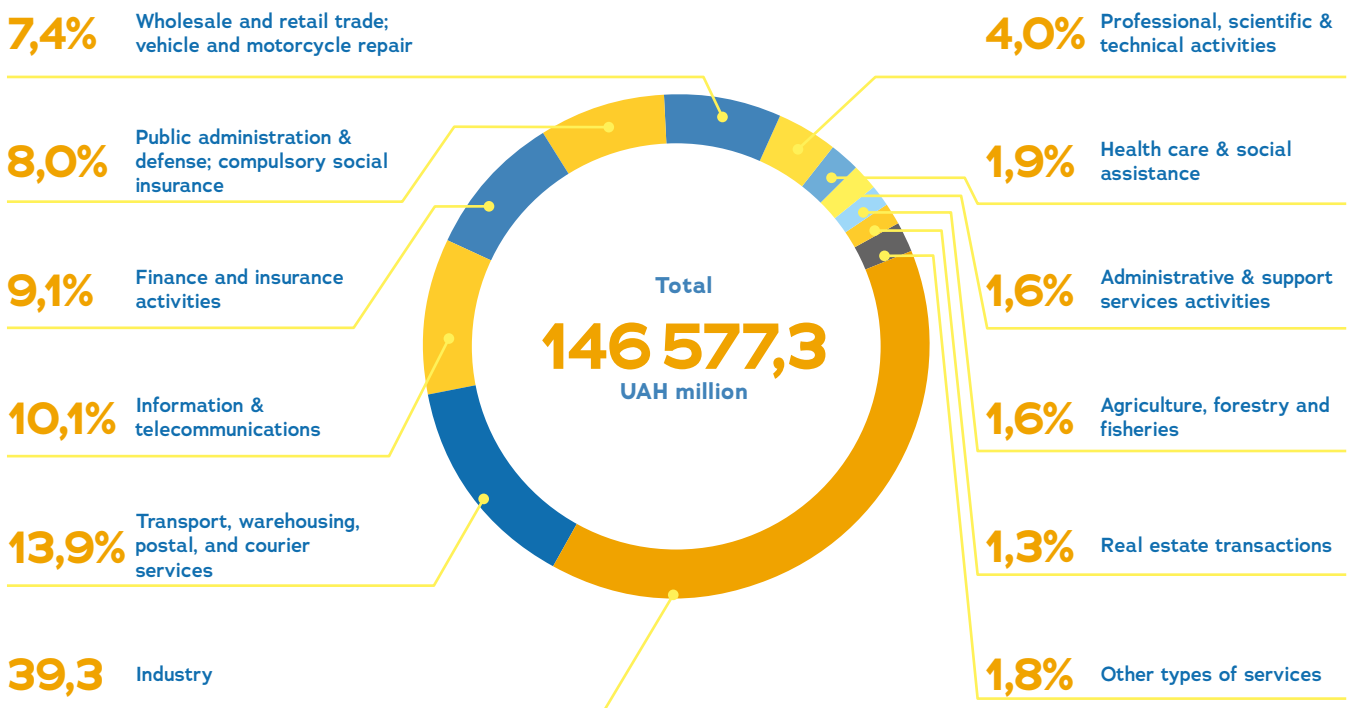

Capital investments of Kyiv, UAH million

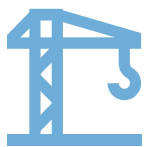


Capital investments of Kyiv by type of economic activity, %

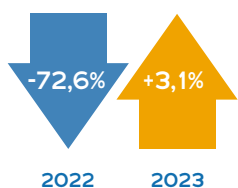

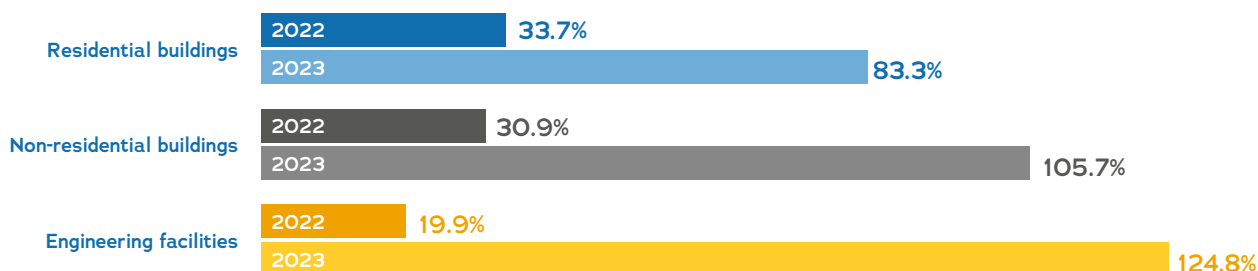

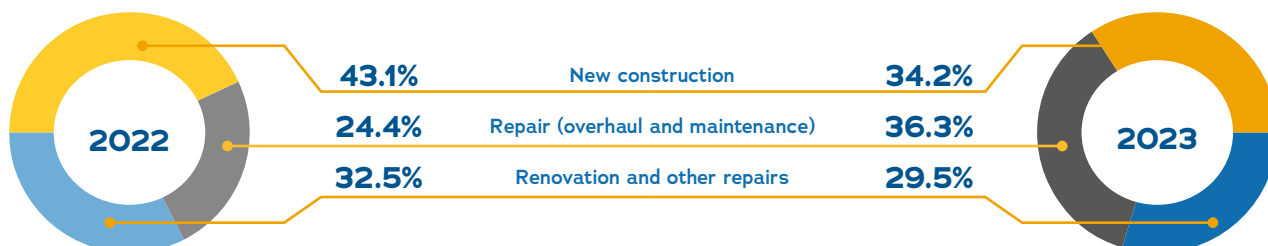

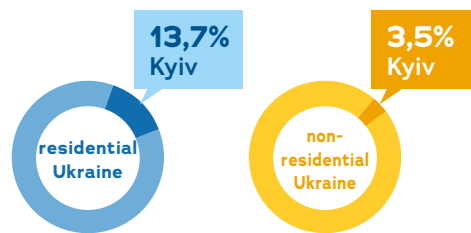
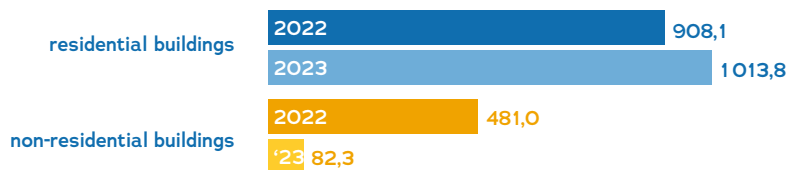
Index of construction products by type



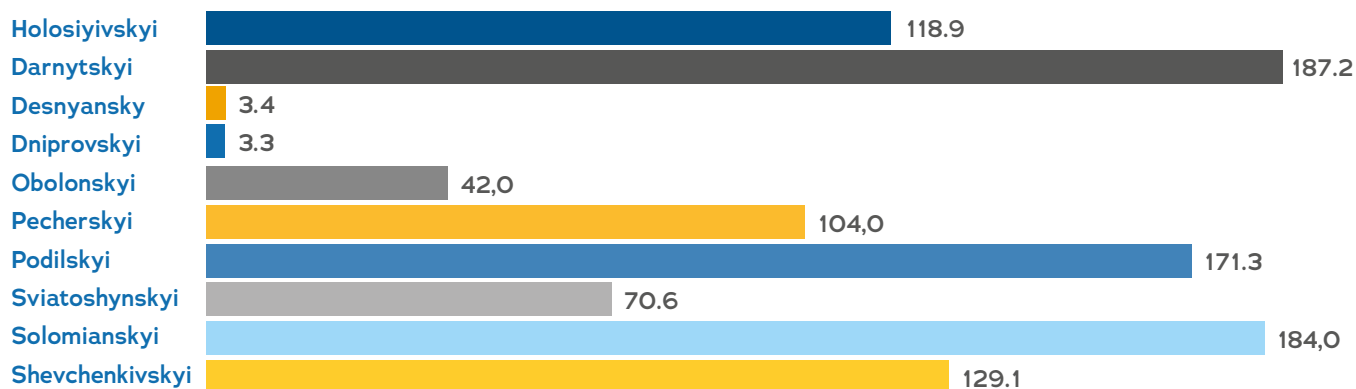
Distribution of volumes of construction products by the nature of the construction

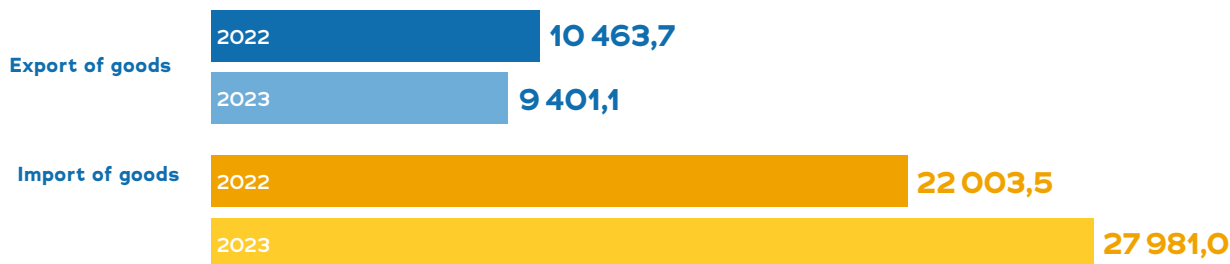

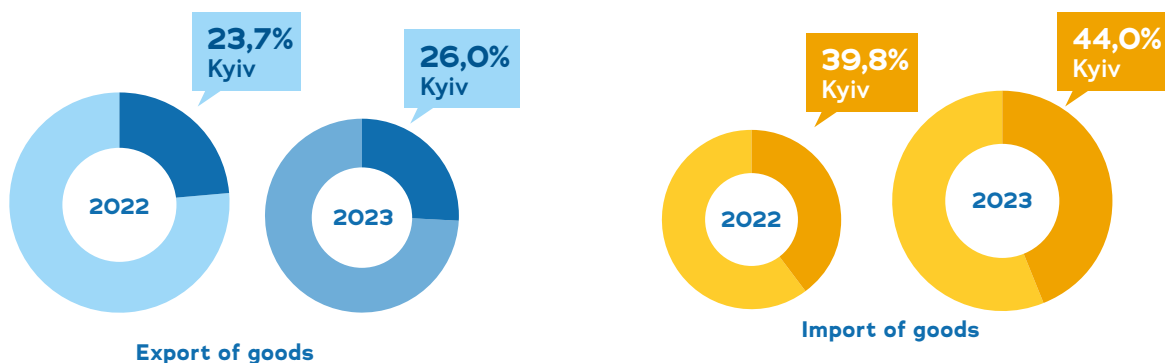

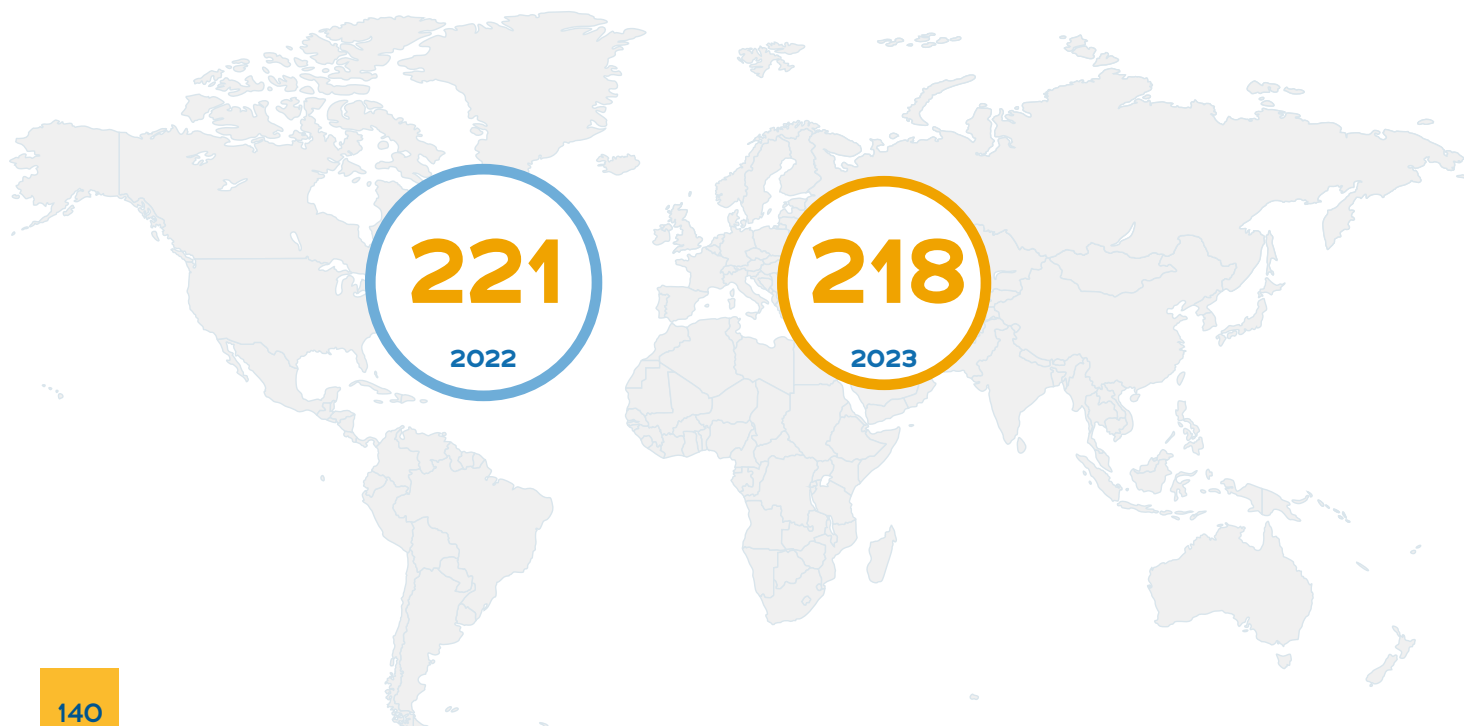
Foreign trade in goods, million USD



Share of Kyiv in Ukraine



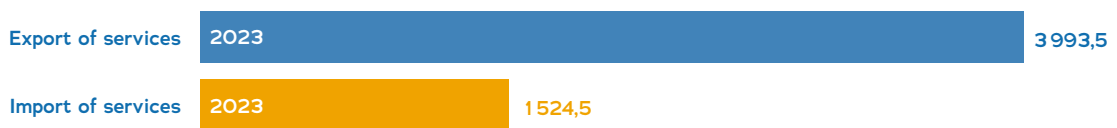
Number of countries in the world with which foreign trade transactions on trade in goods were conducted



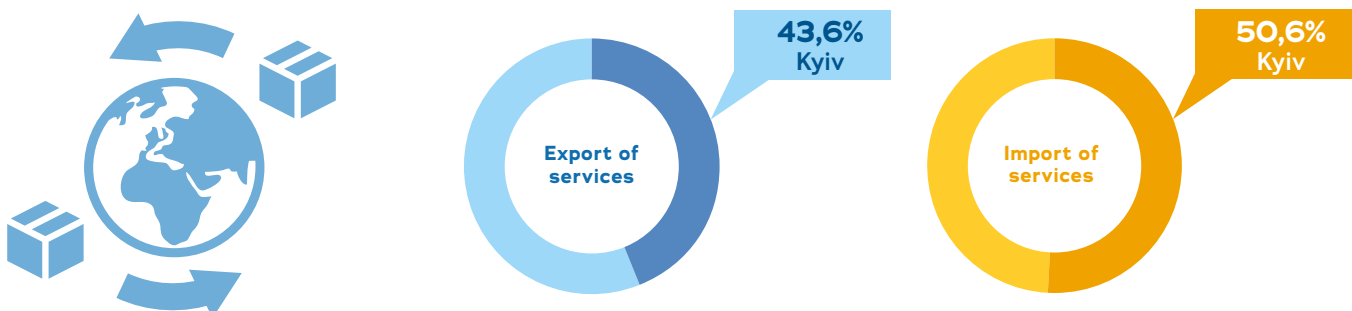
Commodity structure of foreign trade, million USD
